Mayor Harwood opened the hearing for public input on parking changes proposed after concerns about emergency vehicle traffic blocked from streets with overcrowded parking. Council is considering parking changes on Holly Place, Spruce St., and Maple St.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Dale Ward believes something should be done about the parking, but doesn't think enough people attended the hearing.

Almond said council will host a second public hearing in January and notice will be delivered to residents in areas of proposed changes weeks prior to the hearing.

Ron Dorsey of Holly Place asked what's under consideration. He believes alleys are too narrow for large vehicles. Almond said Holly Place may need off-street parking.
